VA Black Hills Health Care System to Host OEF/OIF Veteran Tele-Health Clinics in Scottsbluff, NE and Rosebud, SD

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Black Hills Health Care System invites Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom (OEF/OIF) Veterans from the Scottsbluff, NE and Rosebud, SD areas to participate in specialized tele-health clinics.

The tele-health clinics will allow Veterans to visit with an OEF/OIF Care Manager from VA Black Hills Health Care System while they conveniently remain in their own community. Care Managers are equipped to provide information on care management, health care eligibility, resources, referrals and answer questions on issues specifically related to OEF/OIF Veteran health care.

The tele-health clinics will be offered in:

- Scottsbluff, NE at the Scottsbluff Community Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC), 1720 E Portal Place the 1st Wednesday of each month from 8:00am-4:00pm.
- Rosebud, SD at the Rosebud Vet Center the 2nd Wednesday of each month from 1:00pm-4:00pm.

“This is a unique opportunity for the VA to provide outreach services to OEF/OIF Veterans in Scottsbluff and Rosebud using tele-health technology,” said Amber Heinert, OEF/OIF Care Manager for VA Black Hills Health Care System. “This resource allows Veterans to consult with a VA professional regarding their care at a time and place that is convenient for them.”
